


# 2018 SOUTH GEORGIA COUNCIL WEBELOS RENDEZVOUS



**Deadline to Register is November 28<sup>th</sup>**

**Webelos Leaders and Scoutmasters of the same Charter Organization are encouraged to plan and camp together.**

*If attending with a troop, make sure the parents/guardians are aware that they are required to have an adult attend the campout with their Scout.*

The Webelos Rendezvous is a two-night campout for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year Webelos.

The purpose of this event is to inspire the boys to continue in Scouting and cross over into a Boy Scout troop.

A staff will be made up of mostly older Boy Scouts and experienced leaders from different troops throughout the council. These leaders will supervise and lead all the activities and skill events. This way, the Webelos are provided with a full weekend to interact and learn from "older scouts". They will also see what a scout camp looks like while being taught valuable skills like campsite selection, kitchen setup, fire building and knot tying. All scouts will participate in ceremonies, camp wide games, patrol flag competition, evening campfire and see some of what the future has in store for them in the Boy Scouts.

## **Scouting Adventure Requirement for Arrow of Light**

3(d) As a patrol, make plans with a troop to participate in a Boy Scout Troop's campout or other outdoor activity.

4. With your Webelos den leader, parent, or guardian, participate in a Boy Scout troop's campout or other outdoor activity. Use the patrol method while on the outing.

## Patrol Flag Competition Rules

1. Scouts should decide how they will design the Patrol Flag for their unit and work as a team.
2. Each flag must be clearly marked with the unit number and patrol name. Patrol flags should identify patrol members.
3. Flags must be made from leather, wood, cloth or other natural materials. Paper flags will not qualify.
4. Flags may be any shape or form but must not exceed 24 inches in height or 24 inches in width.
5. The flag must be attached to a pole.
6. Flags should represent the Webelos scouts' work not the adults' work.
7. Durability, portability, use of scout skills, artistic design, originality and team work will be judged. Everyone should be involved in designing the patrol flag.

Firebowl: The Saturday evening Firebowl will include Webelos skits/songs and presentation of awards to Webelos Patrols. Any patrol wishing to participate should notify registration no later than Saturday dinner. Patrol flags will be staged at the entrance to the Firebowl to be judged during the skits.
